Grilled, skinless chicken breast topped with swiss cheese and ham.

Broasted Chicken - \$12.95

Two pieces of bone-in chicken that is hand breaded. All white for an additional \$1.50.

Hähnchen Schnitzel - \$12.95

Chicken breast breaded in our schnitzel blend and grilled.

Smoked Pork Chop - \$12.95 🇺🇸

Applewood smoked and topped with Fuji apples.

Jäger Schnitzel - \$12.95

Breaded and grilled and served with mushroom gravy on the side.

Oven Baked Steak - \$12.95

Tender beef slow cooked in its own gravy with caramelized onions.

Wiener Schnitzel - \$12.95

Breaded in our schnitzel spices and grilled.

Sauerbraten - \$13.95

A Ronneburg specialty. Marinated beef in a special blend of seasonings and wine.

Sandwiches

All sandwiches are served with coleslaw. For a \$1.50 extra French fries, a cup of soup, or cottage cheese can be substituted for coleslaw. For \$2.50 extra onion rings or breaded mushrooms.

Reuben - \$8.95

Served on marbled rye bread with corned beef, sauerkraut, and swiss cheese. Thousand Island is served on the side.

Pork Tenderloin - \$7.95

Thick pork cut that is breaded and fried.

Brat & Kraut - \$6.95

Bratwurst from our local Amana Meat Shop. Mild and served on a bun with sauerkraut on the side.

Hamburger - \$6.95

Additional \$.55 for American cheese, \$1.00 for bacon.

Swissburger - \$7.95

With swiss cheese, grilled onions, and mushrooms.

The Builder - \$8.95

Hot roast beef sandwich covered in gravy. Served with fried potatoes in the center.

Schnitzel Sandwich - \$7.95

Your choice of wiener, jäger, or hähnchen served on either marbled rye bread or a brioche bun.

History of the Ronneburg Restaurant

The restaurant is named after a castle in Hesse, Germany, bearing also the name of "Ronneburg". The castle has significance in the Amana community, as it was where the town ancestors fled to in the 18th century to avoid religious prosecution. Several pictures of the Ronneburg Castle can be seen in our main dining room.

Built in 1860, the Ronneburg Restaurant first started off as a communal kitchen. The atmosphere in the dining room differed considerably from the communal days. Back then, the men ate at one table while the women and children ate at another. Fifteen minutes were allowed for a meal and you were expected to use it for eating. Conversation was frowned upon and music was strictly forbidden.

In 1950, the Ronneburg Restaurant opened it's doors and has been serving German family style food ever since!
